We have great pleasure in introducing our new Head Girl and Head Boy for St Peter's.

We had over 20 applications this year!

Following the shortlisting process, we then interviewed. A series of searching questions all about how they would influence the school community and make the role their own. The interview culminated in the challenging question... "If you were a dessert, which dessert would you be and why...?"

There was a task to read aloud-the role does require the Head Girl and Boy to read aloud in Collective Worship-and each candidate was scored..... you could say it was a real life experience of a real job interview!

The decision was incredibly hard. All the children who applied were kind, considered and passionate about representing their school with such pride. We decided that each young person who applied had earned themselves a pack of really nice pens and a thank you card from me. Their quality and qualities made the decision really tough.

I could not be prouder of each of them-parents you really do have exceptional children! A huge thank you to all our young people who took the time to apply-the field was very strong.

So, after this process, consideration and deliberation we have great delight in introducing our new Head Girl, Jessica Smith and our new Head Boy, Alex Jaruk. Congratulations to them both.

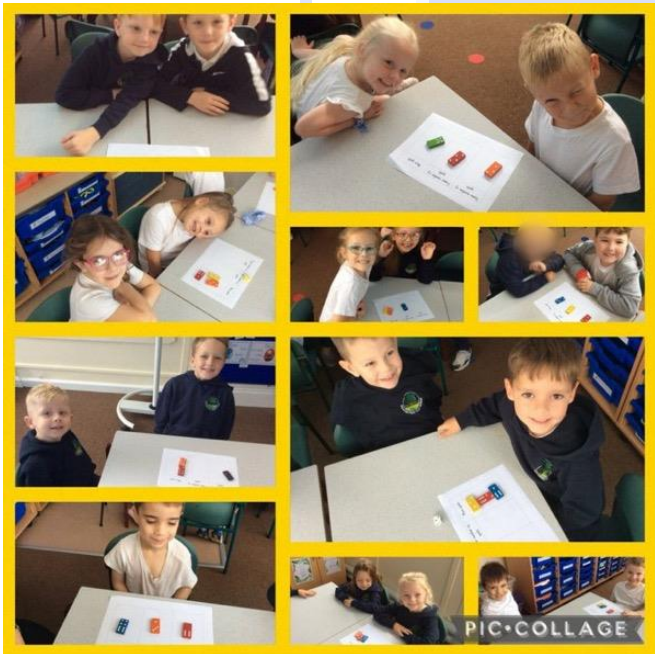
